

Privacy Notice

Hello, dear!

It's nice to see you in this page. It means that you pay attention to your privacy. And I'm glad to have a chance explaining to you the way I collect and treat information about you. This notice describes PatentBot, Inc. privacy policy for the Patent Bot Software (the "Software") and patentbot.online website including all its services and functions (collectively the "Services"). The terms "I", "me" "my" refer to PatentBot, Inc. I am committed to safeguarding the privacy of my Services users.

What information do I collect?

To provide certain services, I collect following personal information from you:

1. My Services are based on the Facebook Messenger or Website by the following link [Patentbot.online](https://patentbot.online) (hereinafter – **Website**). I collect your **account name** and **information about the language** you are using from your Facebook profile. This information allows me to personalize communication with you. If you're using the Website I collect the information related to your data in Google or Facebook.
2. When you do TM search I will ask for your e-mail to send you search results.
3. I will require information about the trademark ("TM"), which you want to register, and other additional information. This includes: **desired country of TM registration; language of communication; desired name for TM; list of classes for registration and area of TM use; for Ukraine type of registration (standard procedure / accelerated procedure); for the USA type of registration (Actually using mark in commerce now / No use of mark yet); for the EU – the type of alphabet for TM**. I need this information to specify the Services, which I provide to you;
4. After specification, I will need the following additional information for the application form: **your full name (the name of the company and its registration number), full address of residence, e-mail, telephone number**. I use this information solely to fill the TM application form or I will forward this information to my partners who act on my behalf;
5. If you are filing the application for the Ukrainian, Russian, Belarus, Kazakhstan or China trademark offices, I will also require **the power of attorney, which authorizes me or my partners to apply for a TM registration on your behalf**;
6. If you are filing the application for the US trademark office, I may require additional information: **the date of first TM use and any evidence of it** (photos of goods with TM on it, a website that shows the connection between TM and any goods or services etc.);

7. For application in China I may require transliteration of your data on Chinese; **I also need the scan-copy of your ID card / Passport of the scan-copy of the Certificate of Registration of the company (or similar document)**
8. To timestamp the authorship, I will need the information about your work, which you want to register, and other additional information for the appropriate authorship recording. This includes: **the title; description of the work; date of creation; information about the author, including full name or pseudonym, date of birth, place of residence/place of registration, and email; the work itself; type of copyright, and the subtype.** I use this information solely to mark the time of creation of your work, which results in establishment of authorship.
Please note, that the title of the work, the name of the author / artist / composer (or pseudonym), and the date and time of registration of the work will be publicly available through my blockchain system.
9. To apply for provisional patent application in the US, I will need the information **your full name (the name of the company and its registration number) or the actual information about the applicant, full address of residence, e-mail, telephone number, information about the author of the invention (his/her name and full address of residence).**
10. After you pay off our services through one of the provided payment systems, I will receive your payment information from them, including **payment status, your payment ID, payment amount and its currency, payment system fee, a destination of payment, and the date of payment.** This information confirms that the services were paid off; and
11. If you want to amend your TM application in any way, I will collect from you information that can help me identify your application and the amended information.
12. I also collect your **advertiser ID** when you follow the link to my Services from any advertisement on the websites of third parties. I use this information solely to assess the effectiveness of my advertising.
13. Personal information submitted on my Services will be used only for the purposes specified in this privacy notice.

Your Consent

My processing of your Personal Information is based on the following grounds:

- **your consent** to use the information from your Facebook profile. You can withdraw your consent at any time. You can usually do it by sending an appropriate message to my Software. This withdrawal will not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before;
- other information I collect is **necessary to provide the services** for you. Without this information I will be unable to provide you with the services; and
- the use of advertiser IDs is based on **my legitimate interest** – it is used for my marketing purposes. It can be sent to the third parties in the aggregated and anonymous form.

Sharing your personal information with third parties

To register the trademark, the information filed in the application must be sent to the trademark office - a governmental or intergovernmental organization which controls the issue of trademarks.

Depending on the country of registration, I will send information about the trademark, which you want to register, and other information that is contained in the application form to:

- United States Patent and Trademark Office (<https://www.uspto.gov>) – if you want to register a trademark in the United States;
- European Union Intellectual Property Office (<https://euipo.europa.eu>) - if you want to register a trademark in the European Union or any country of the European Union;
- Ukrainian Intellectual Property Institute (<http://www.uipv.org/en/>) – if you want to register a trademark in Ukraine;
- National Intellectual Property Administration (<http://english.sipo.gov.cn/>) - if you want to register a trademark in China;
- Rospatent (<https://rupto.ru/en>) – if you want to register a trademark in Russia;
- National Center of Intellectual Property (<http://belgopatent.by/eng/>) – if you want to register a trademark in Belarus, and
- National Institute of Intellectual Property (<https://www.kazpatent.kz/en>) – if you want to register a trademark in Kazakhstan.

I provide payment systems of third parties to pay for my services. These third parties are:

- Liqpay (<https://www.liqpay.ua/>) – if you are paying for a trademark in the European Union or Ukraine; or
- Paypal (<https://www.paypal.com/us/home>) - if you are paying for a trademark in the United States, the European Union.

I provide these payment systems with your user ID (I generate it for your application), payment ID and payment amount. Any other personal information you give directly to these third parties. The use of this information will be governed by privacy policies of them.

I may provide your information to my partners that assist me in filing trademark applications in Russia, Kazakhstan, Belarus and China, the US and EU and provisional patent applications in the US. I also may transmit your data to the partners who handle any problems during the trademark registration process in abovementioned countries. I ensure that I have concluded Data Processing Agreements with my partners in accordance with GDPR.

Retaining your Personal Information

I will store your Personal Information till it is necessary to carry out my obligations regarding the services I provide to you. This period lasts to 30 months and can be extended in specific cases. I will not store your information if it is not used anymore for the purposes listed in this privacy notice.

Cookies

I use cookies, as almost all websites do, to help provide you with the best experience I can.

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer or mobile phone when you browse websites.

Cookies help me to:

- Work as you'd expect;
- Save you having to login every time you visit the site;
- Remember your settings during and between visits;
- Improve the speed/security of the site;
- Allow you to share pages with social networks such as Facebook;
- Continuously improve me for you.

I use cookies to make my website work, including:

- Determining if you are logged in or not;
- Remembering if you have already answered certain questions (eg, so that you don't need to fill in your details twice.)

I do not use cookies to:

- Collect any personally identifiable information (without your express permission);
- Collect any sensitive information (without your express permission);
- Pay sales commissions.

I will not set cookies without your explicit consent to do so. You can approve my use of cookies by clicking "OK, I agree" on the banner that appears when you first visit my website. If you do not permit me to store cookies, you will still be able to use the website.

If you are uncomfortable with the use of cookies, you can manage and control them through your browser, including removing cookies by deleting them from your "browser history" when you leave the site.

Other disclosures

In addition to the disclosures for the purposes identified elsewhere in this privacy notice, I may disclose information about you:

- to the extent that I am required to do so by law;
- in connection with any legal proceedings or prospective legal proceedings;
- to establish, exercise or defend my legal rights (including providing information to others for the purposes of fraud prevention and reducing credit risk); and
- to the purchaser or seller (or prospective purchaser or seller) of any business or asset which I am (or are contemplating) selling or purchasing.

Except as provided in this privacy notice, I will not sell, share or rent your information to third parties.

Your Rights

Regarding your Personal Information, you have the right to request me:

- an access to the information that was collected;
- to update and keep information accurate;
- to delete any undesirable collected information;
- to restrict the processing of the information;
- to stop the processing of the information in case that the information is used for direct marketing purposes; and
- to send your Personal Information to any third party.

You can complete requests by contacting me at me@patentbot.online.

However, I cannot delete your email address until your TM will either be registered or denied in registration. I will use your email address only to contact you regarding the registration status of your TM and keep you informed about general registration procedures and my related services. If you want to delete both the information I keep and the information that trademark office keep, you will have to cancel your TM registration application.

If you believe that my use of your Personal Information violates your rights, you can lodge a complaint with your national data protection authority. But I hope I won't get there.

Security of your personal information

Your personal information is being stored and processed in Lithuania.

I provide all organizational and technical measures for the data protection, including encryption and pseudonymization of your personal information.

I take necessary and sufficient organizational and technical measures to protect your information from unauthorized or accidental access, destruction, modification, blocking, copying, distribution, as well as from other illegal actions of third parties.

Immediate access to the Personal Information is allowed only to my authorized employees involved in providing the services. Such employees keep strict confidentiality and prevent unauthorized third-party access to personal information.

Changes to the privacy notice

I may update this privacy notice from time-to-time by posting a new version in my Services. I advise you to check this page occasionally to ensure you are happy with any changes. However, I will endeavor to provide you with the announcement about any significant changes.

Third-party services
